Neville Sanjana is a Core Faculty Member at the New York Genome Center, and an Assistant Professor of Biology, Neuroscience and Physiology at NYU. Dr. Sanjana is a recipient of the NIH Pathway to Independence Award, the Melanoma Research Alliance Young Investigator Award, a Sidney Kimmel Scholar, and a Next Generation Leader for the Paul Allen Institute for Brain Science. The Sanjana Lab develops new genome engineering technologies for functional genomics, cancer biology, and neurodevelopmental disorders. Prior to joining the New York Genome Center and NYU, Dr. Sanjana was a Simons Postdoctoral Fellow at the Broad Institute of Harvard and MIT. He holds a Ph.D. in Brain and Cognitive Sciences from MIT and a BS in Symbolic Systems and a BA in English from Stanford University.
